B And it was already 10 o'clock — so I ¹⁸ (decide) to stay at home anyway!

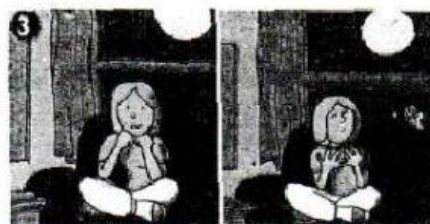
