Measurement-MASS

LO: To add and subtract mass in kilogram and grams.

Instructions: Complete the working in your Math notebook.

EXAMPLE:

There are 1000 grams in a kilogram.

$$1000\text{g} = 1\text{kg}$$

$$600\text{ g} + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 1\text{kg?}$$

$$600\text{g} + \underline{400}\text{ g} = 1\text{kg}$$

a. $25\text{g} + 65\text{g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{g}$

b. $250\text{ g} + 150\text{g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{g}$

c. $360\text{g} + 140\text{g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{g}$

d. $350\text{ g} + 250\text{g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{g}$

e. $450\text{g} + 250\text{ g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{g}$

f. $550\text{g} + 250\text{g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{g}$

g. $500\text{g} + \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ g} = 1\text{kg}$

h. $450\text{g} + \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ g} = 1\text{kg}$

i. $700\text{ g} - 200\text{g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{g}$

j. $1000\text{ g} - 900\text{ g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{g}$
