

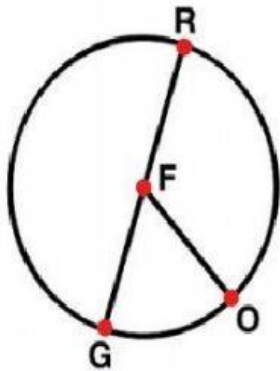
Circles

A diameter is a line segment that passes through the center of a circle. It has two points on the outside edge of the circle.

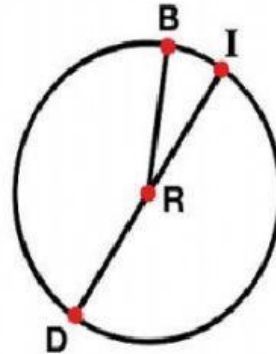
