Passive voice (present simple, past simple, present perfect, future simple)

Active voice (<i>Darāmā kārta</i>)	Passive voice (<i>Ciešamā kārta</i>)
PRESENT SIMPLE <i>am/is/are + verb 3rd column</i>	
I do my homework. Peter writes comments.	The homework is done by me. Comments are written by Peter.
PAST SIMPLE <i>was/were + verb 3rd column</i>	
I did my homework. Peter wrote comments.	The homework was done by me. Comments were written by Peter.
PRESENT PERFECT <i>have/has been + verb 3rd column</i>	
I have done my homework. Peter has written comments.	The homework has been done by me. Comments have been written by Peter.
FUTURE SIMPLE <i>will be + verb 3rd column</i>	
I will do my homework. Peter will write comments.	The homework will be done by me. Comments will be written by Peter.
