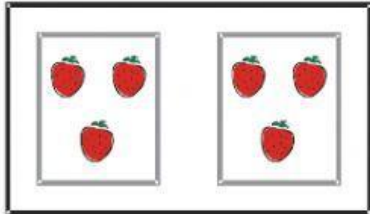
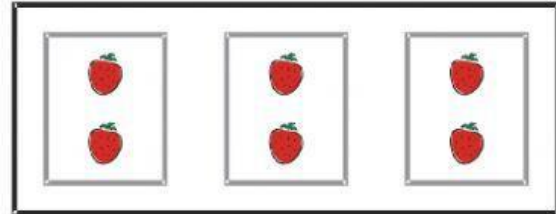


Propiedades conmutativa de la multiplicación

a) Propiedad conmutativa:



$$2 \times 3 = 6$$



$$3 \times 2 = 6$$

Entonces: $2 \times 3 = 3 \times 2$
