Fantasy books **are written** by him.

ARE
IS + **III forma

PAST SIMPLE

Someone **stole** his bike.
His bike **was stolen**.
Anna **chose** this house.
This house **was chosen** by Anna.

WAS
WERE + **III forma
casoanikai / -ed**

TEACH & sketch

PRESENT PERFECT

Mike **has suggested** a new idea.
A new idea **has been suggested** by Mike.
They **have found** a few bones in the park.
A few bones **have been found** in the park.

HAVE
HAS **BEEN** + **III forma
casoanikai / -ed**

FUTURE SIMPLE

He **will paint** our living room.
Our living room **will be painted** by him.
They **will sell** their house.
Their house **will be sold**.

WILL BE + **III forma
casoanikai / -ed**
