Choose IS or ARE:

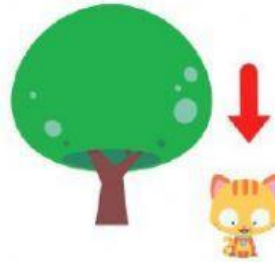
1. There **IS** one frog on the log.

2. There **IS** two cats next to the log.
 ARE



3. There **IS** one cat by a tree.
 ARE



4. There **IS** one cat in a bag.
 ARE



5. There **IS** two frogs under a rock.
 ARE
