**Commas in a series**- We use commas to separate lists of things.

Example: I went to the store and bought apples, grapes, and pears.

I like the colors red yellow and green.	yes	no

She has a pet dog cat and hamster.	yes	no

**Commas in dates-** We use commas to separate dates. The comma separates the day of the week and day of the month.

Example:

Today is Monday, April 26, 2021.

Yesterday was April 25, 2021.

They went to the beach on Saturday, July 4th.	yes	no
Tommy had a birthday party on Friday, June 7, 2021.	yes	no
Christmas this year is on Saturday December 25 2021.	yes	no
Memorial Day is on Monday, May 31st.	yes	no
Her birthday was Monday September 1 2000.	yes	no

**Commas in places**- We use commas to separate places. The comma separates the county or city from the name of the state.

Example: We went to New York City, New York.

Did you go to Blacksburg Virginia?	yes	no
He went to Virginia Beach, Virginia this summer.	yes	no
I went to New York City New York in the spring.	yes	no
She visited Atlanta, Georgia with her family.	yes	no
They went to Nashville, Tennessee last year.	yes	no
