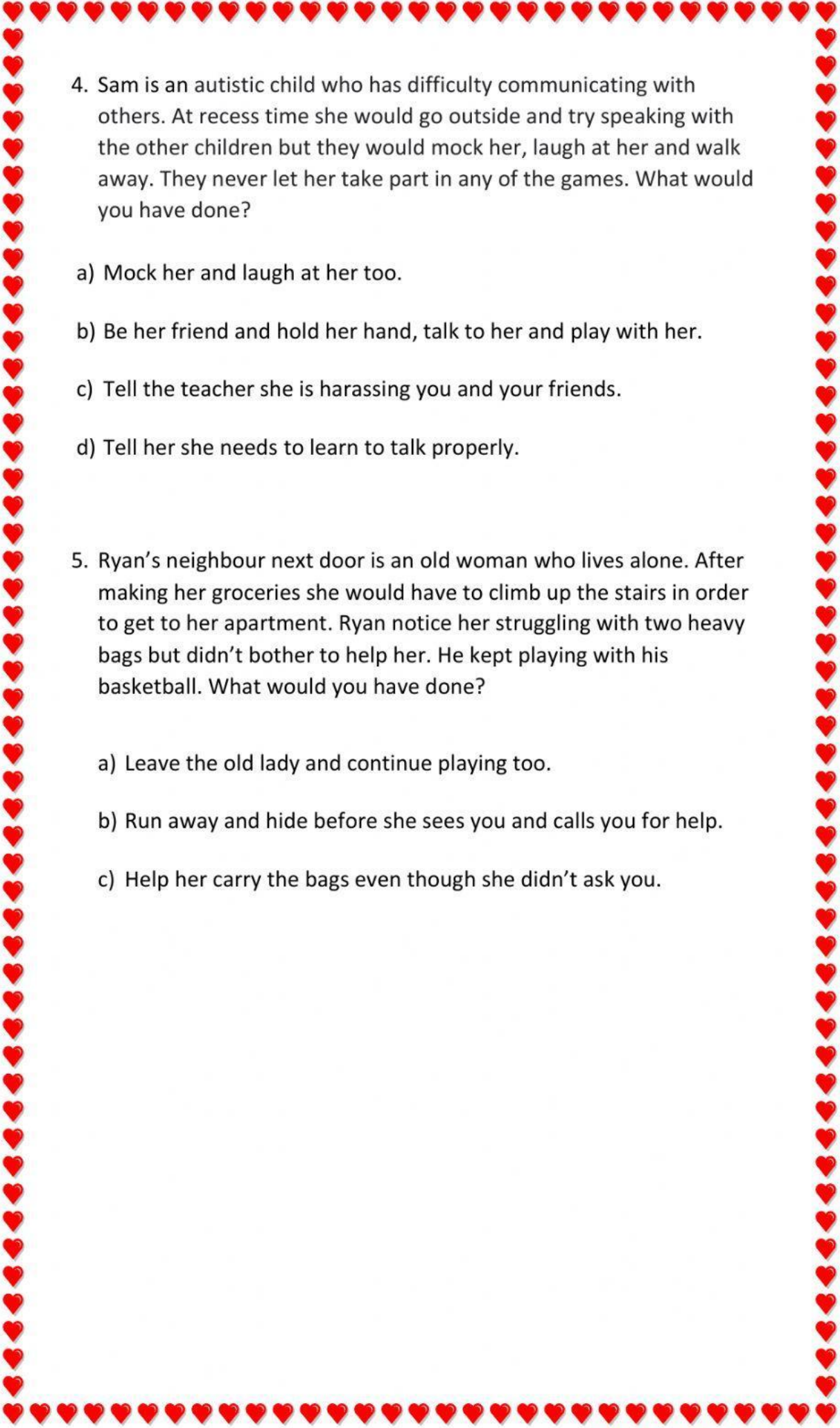


SHOWING FAIRNESS TO EVERYONE
