

Linking sounds in English

Linking consonants to vowels

Re-type the phrase highlighting the connecting sounds.

e.g. I have a question. [I h**av**a question.]

1. Where do I attach it?
2. Walk over here.
3. Can we please listen again?
4. Let's catch up after class.
5. I like to jog in the morning.

Linking vowels to vowels

Insert **w** or **y** where they are used to link sounds.

e.g. Does anyone listen to the radio? [Does anyone listen to the radi**y**o?]

I sometimes do in the car [I sometimes do**w**in the car.]

Note: select **w** or **y** in sequence from the left.

w w w w w w y y y y y y

1. Would you like some tea and biscuits?
2. He told me it would be here today.
3. Give me a minute to think.
4. We are going to study later.
5. I will go out later.
6. I feel so angry right now!
7. Maybe it's a good idea.
8. Is he alright?
9. Are you alright?
10. The freezer is too icy!
