


Comparatives and Superlatives

1. Use the comparative or the superlative form.




James Tom Robert

Robert is the (fat)




Oliver David John

John is the (young)




Cheetah Turtle Rabbit

The cheetah is the(fast)




Sam Tom Max

Sam is the (angry)




David's family Ann's family George's family


