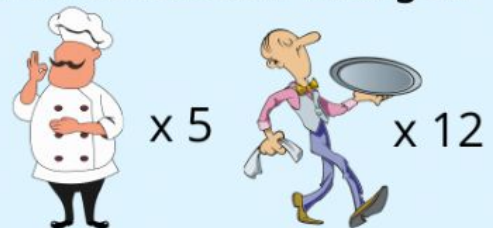


Our restaurant is called Bigga Burgers.
