


BIOLOGICAL DRAWINGS

- i. The drawing below has been poorly drawn and labelled.
- ii. Drag the number of the problem to the correct area on the diagram.

| 1 | There should be no arrowheads on label lines. |
| 2 | Use smooth unbroken lines in the drawing. |
| 3 | Labels go at the ends of the label lines. |
| 4 | Labels should be in all capital OR all common letters only. |
| 5 | Titles must have magnification included at the end. |
| 6 | Labels should be in all capital OR all common letters only. |
| 7 | Label lines should not cross. |
| 8 | There should be no shading. |
| 9 | Use smooth unbroken lines in the drawing. |
| 10 | Labels should be outside of the drawing itself. |
| 11 | Title should be under the drawing and underlined. |
| 12 | Labels should be in all capital OR all common letters only. |
| 13 | There should be no double lines on the drawing. |
| 14 | Place drawing on the left and label on the right. |
