## *Read then answer the questions*

"Emmett Till was born in Chicago and grew up in a middle-class Black neighborhood. In 1955, Till was visiting relatives in Money, a Southern town in Jim Crow Mississippi. He was accused of whistling at Carolyn Bryant, a white woman who was a cashier at a grocery store.

Four days later, Bryant's husband Roy and his half-brother J.W. Milam kidnapped Till, beat him and shot him in the head. He was only 14 years old. The men were tried for murder, but an all-white, male jury acquitted them.

Till's murder and open casket funeral galvanized the emerging **civil rights movement**. More than six decades later, in January 2017, Timothy Tyson, author of *The Blood of Emmett Till* and a senior research scholar at Duke University, revealed that in a 2007 interview Carolyn admitted to him that she had lied about Till making advances toward her."
