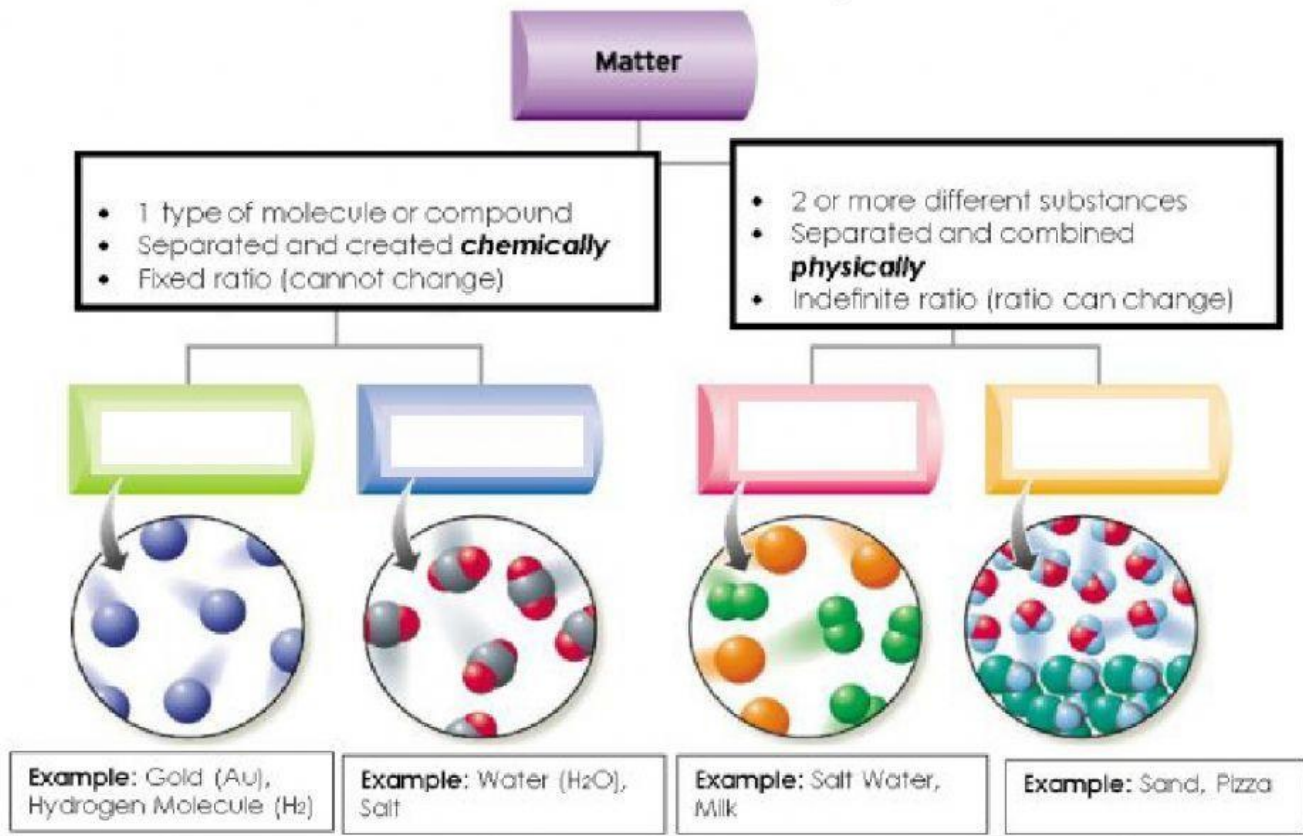
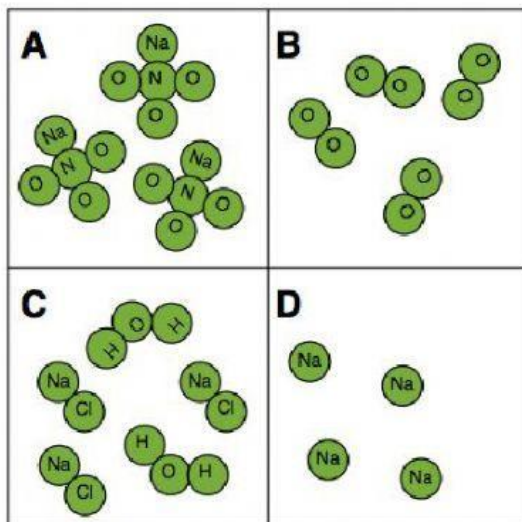


Kinds of Matter
