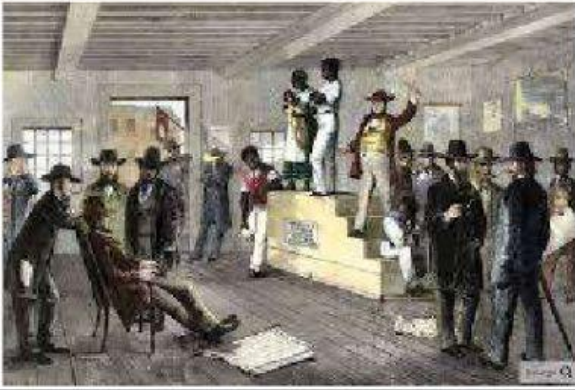


Life on the plantations.

sugar, rice or cotton plantations. (oblige)



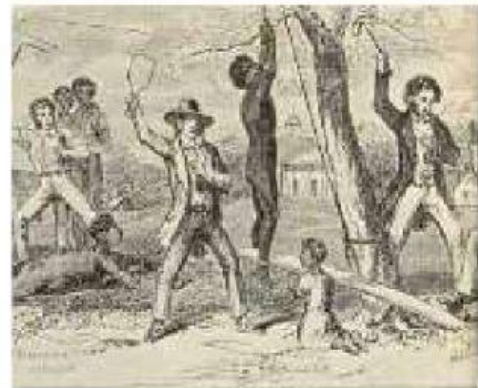
