

Put the **adverb** or **expression of frequency** in the sentence.

Expressions of frequency (AT THE END OF THE SENTENCE)

every day, twice a week, three times a month

Adverbs of frequency (BEFORE THE VERB)

always, never, sometimes, usually, often, rarely

examples:

I study English **every day**.

I **always** study English.

I study English **twice a day**.

I **never** study English.

1. My son shares his toys with his friends. (always)

2. I spend time with my family on the weekend. (usually)

3. Students come to class. (5 days a week)

4. My boss gives me time off in the summer. (rarely)

5. We have a vocabulary quiz. (every Friday)

6. It snows in April. (rarely)

7. My mother calls me. (once a day)

8. That student arrives late to class. (often)

9. The dentist wants to see me. (twice a year)
