Yes/No-Questions

auxiliary verb	+	subject	(+ main verb)	+	rest of the question	?
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Examples:

Is your mum a teacher? → Yes, she is.

Is she working now? → No, she isn't.

Are you 20 years old? → No, I'm not.

Is your dog big? → No, it isn't.

Do you live in Argentina? → Yes, I do.

Does your mother work in a hospital? → No, she doesn't.

WH-Questions

Wh word	+	auxiliary verb	+	subject	(+ main verb)	+	rest of the question	?
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Examples:

What is your name? → *My name is Ana.*

How old are you? → *I'm 23 years old.*

Where do you study? → *I study at UNLAM.*

What is your father doing at the moment? → *He is working.*

What do you eat for breakfast? → *I have coffee and toasts.*
