Eating fruit is good for your body.

- ✓ We use the -ing form as a **subject** of the verb.

I **love** drawing flowers.

Jane **can't stand** eating fish.

- ✓ We use the -ing form after feeling expressions (**love/ hate/ enjoy/ can't stand...etc**).

Start cleaning your room!

My friends **go** skiing every Friday.

- ✓ We also use the -ing form after the verbs **start, go and stop**.

I'm **good at** baking cake.

I'm **bad at** swimming.

- ✓ We also use the -ing form after the expression **good at/ bad at**.
