We can also use **when** instead of **if**, for example:
When I work in the lab, I wear a lab coat.

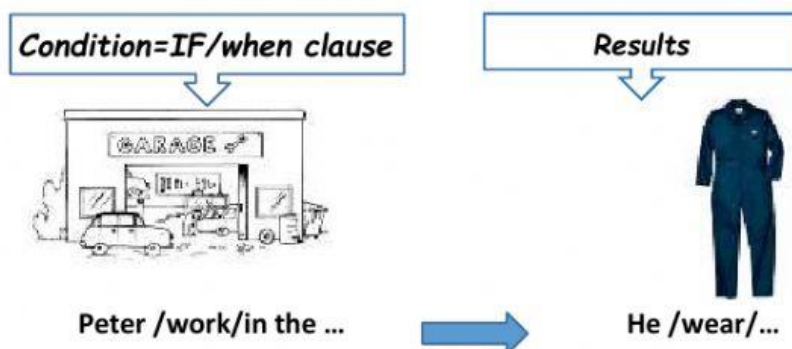

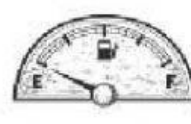
