Culture: The **alebrijes** are imaginary creatures that have elements from different animals such as dragon bodies, bat wings, wolf teeth, and dog eyes. Colorfully painted, they were originally made with papier-mâché but nowadays they are also carved from wood.

The colorful history of Alebrijes



The alebrijes of Mexico have a **story / history** as colorful as the art itself.

It all began in **1936 / 1946** with the artist Pedro Linares. At the age of **30**, he **become / became** ill with a fever and began to have some interesting dreams, hallucinations if you will.

During these **dreams / dreamer**, brightly colored **strange / stranger** animals would appear and Linares kept hearing the word alebrijes as he **sleep / slept**, when he woke up Linares began recreating these mysterious animals out of paper mâché. **Sculping / Sculped** them to display **difference / different** body parts from different animals and painting them in vivid bright colors. No two are exactly alike.

These pieces of are grew in **popular / popularity** and eventually became a staple in the **Tijuana / Oxaca**, region of Mexico where many are now **made / make** of wood. This celebrated art can be found year-round and on day of the **diet / dead**. when they are placed on **altars / graves**. and used as decorations for this special celebration.

Activity 2. Design and make your own “alebrije”. Match the pictures with the instruction. Then write the correct order.

- Tear the newspaper into long strips.
- Blend mixture with paintbrush until it forms a smooth consistency.
- Dip a strip of newspaper into the mixture and remove any excess.
Lay the strip over the surface and repeat.
Place the object on a covered surface to dry
- Get all the material: A bowl or large container, white glue, water, your base structure, a paintbrush, and newspaper.
- Find a surface you want to papier-mâché. Examples include a balloon, cardboard or a molded figure.
- Glue mixture: Pour 2-parts white glue and 1-part water into a mixing bowl.
- Color it.
