Thing - animal	← Which →	Verb	That's the car which I bought last year.
Person	← who →	Verb	That's the man who lives in the house on the hill.
That: we use "that" when we talk about: • things, animal • people			That's the car that I bought last year. That's the man that lives in the house on the hill.
Where: we use where when we talk about place.			I forgot where I put my key.
