We use this tense to talk about:

- Actions at the moment of speaking.
- To describe what people/animals are doing in a picture.

We use this tense :

- To make predictions about the future.
- To make promises
- Offers
- Decisions at the moment of speaking.

We use this tense:

- To talk about plans or intentions.
- To make predictions based on present evidence.

We use this tense.

- To talk about habits/routines.
- To talk about eternal truth.

We use it:

- To talk about an action in progress in the past (Usually contrasted with simple past)

We use it :

- To talk about events that started in the past and continue to the present time.
- To talk about recent past actions.
- To express personal experience.

We use this tense:

- To talk about past events
