SINGULAR

I am happy.  
You are at school.  
He is hungry.  
She is a nurse.  
It is big.

I am not sad.  
You aren't at home.  
He isn't thirsty.  
She isn't a pilot.  
It isn't small.

Contraction of "am not" is not possible  
~~amn't~~

isn't = is not

PLURAL

We are early.  
You are students.  
They are quiet.

We aren't late.  
You aren't teachers.  
They aren't noisy.

aren't = are not
