Time Expressions

Present Simple

We use the present simple tense to talk about **routines**, **true facts** and **repeated actions**.

Examples:

Routine:

We have drama lessons every Thursday.

True Fact:

The sun rises in the east and sets in the west.

Repeated action:

I always come to school by car.

She never forgets to do her homework.

Past Simple

We use the past simple tense to talk about **actions that happened** at a certain time **in the past**.

Examples:

I worked non-stop yesterday.

She was at the school café this morning.

They were absent today.

Susan and Mark cleaned their house last weekend.

Last year, we didn't have lessons at school.
