We use one/ones when we do not want to repeat the already mentioned noun.

Използваме one/ones когато не искаме да повтаряме вече споменато съществително име.

ONE

→ refers to the previously mentioned **SINGULAR noun**

Използваме за вече споменато съществително в единствено число

ONES

→ refers to the previously mentioned **PLURAL noun**

Използваме за вече споменато съществително в единствено число

Examples: I don't know which skirt I liked most, the yellow **one** or the blue **one**.
