


# Take away

## Vocabulary

take away, less, altogether



6 take away 2 is 4.

$$6 - 2 = 4$$

**Hint:** Draw the jumps on the **number line** to find out how many altogether.

If the bird eats 3 worms how many are left?



$$8 - 3 = 5$$

If 5 eggs are broken, how many are left?



$$12 - 5 = \boxed{\phantom{00}}$$

If 2 flowers die, how many are left?



$$6 - \boxed{\phantom{00}} = \boxed{\phantom{00}}$$

If 4 birds fly away, how many are left?




$$10 - \boxed{\phantom{00}} = \boxed{\phantom{00}}$$
