

### **Battery Cage system**

The battery cage system is practiced where \_\_\_\_\_ is limited. Each hen is confined to a cage just large enough to permit \_\_\_\_\_. Cages may be arranged in \_\_\_\_\_ with droppings trays. ### **Deep Litter System**

A wall 30cm high is built all around to contain the litter of rice hulls, \_\_\_\_\_ or anything that does not produce too much \_\_\_\_\_. The litter, if deep enough \_\_\_\_\_ bacterial heat to dry the watery \_\_\_\_\_. Accumulation of feces below perches is gotten rid once or twice per week. On the windward side, \_\_\_\_\_ are hung to keep out the rain. There are two tube feeders for every hundred birds and three automatic waterers for every hundred birds.
