bad/good

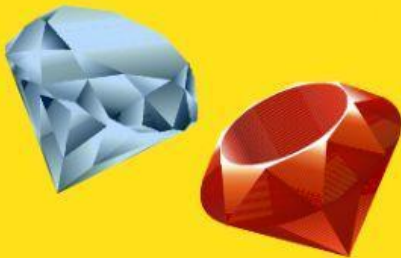
The mark in the 2nd exam is**than** the first one. The mark in the second exam is **the** mark you can get. It's perfect!

The mark in the 1st exam is**than** the second one. It's a fail! The first exam is **not as** **as** the second. Failing an exam is **the**.....result.



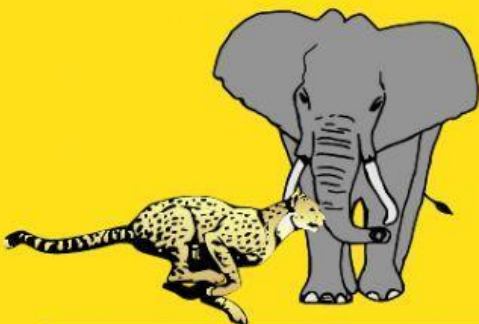
tall /short
