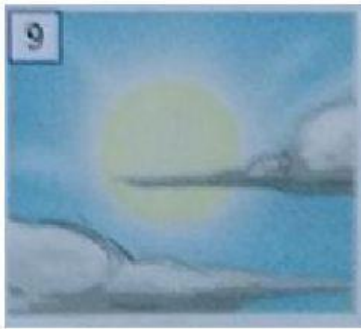

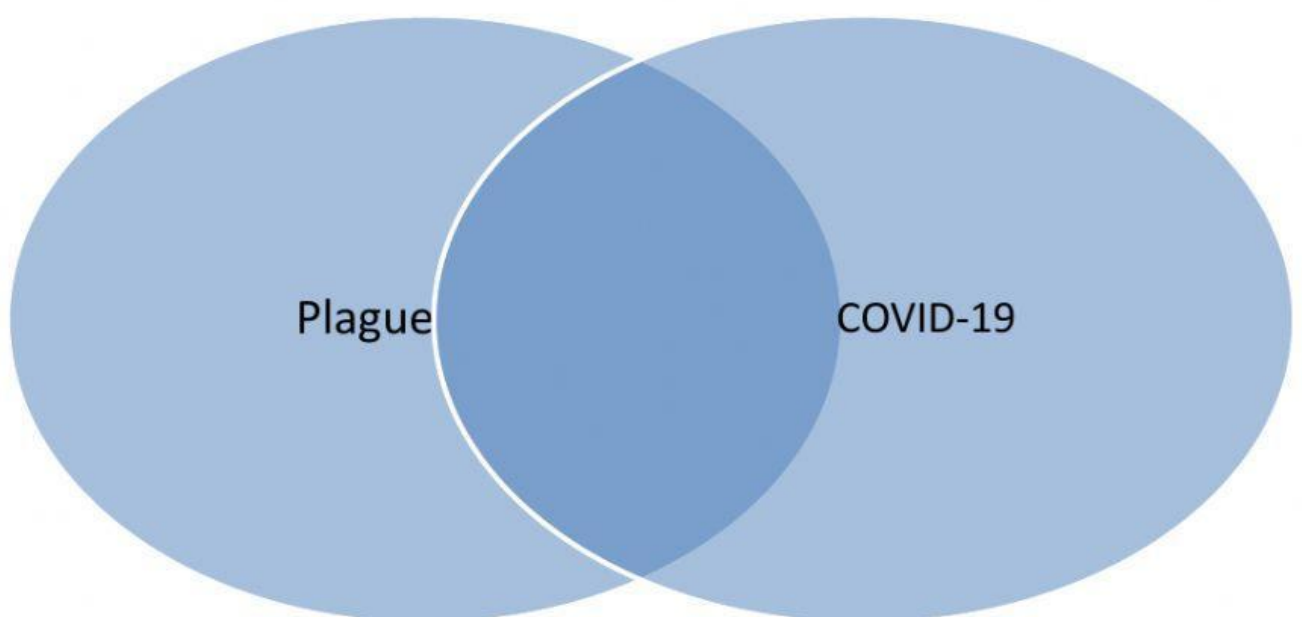






Task 4
