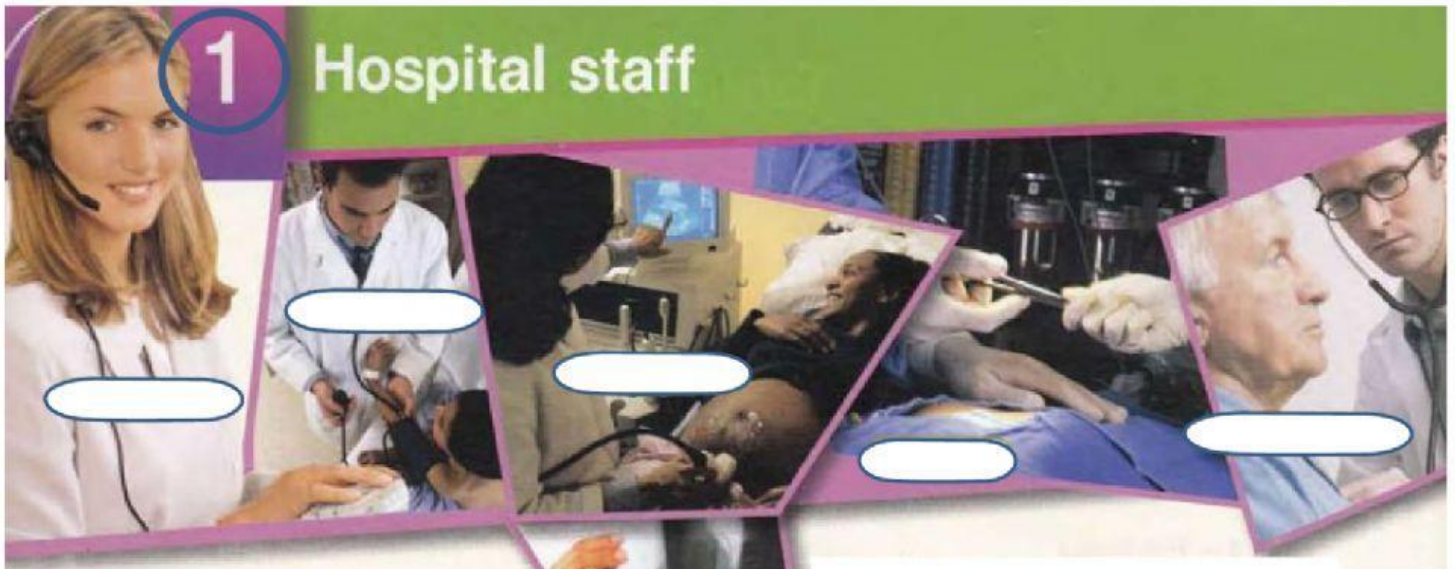

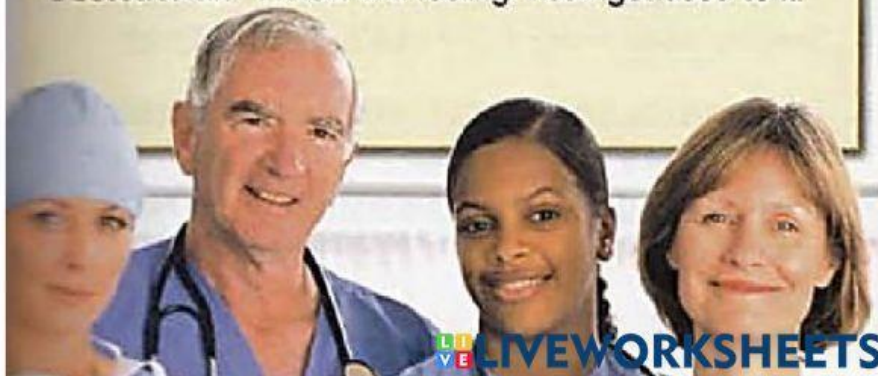

**Obstetrician:** I know the feeling. You'll get used to it.

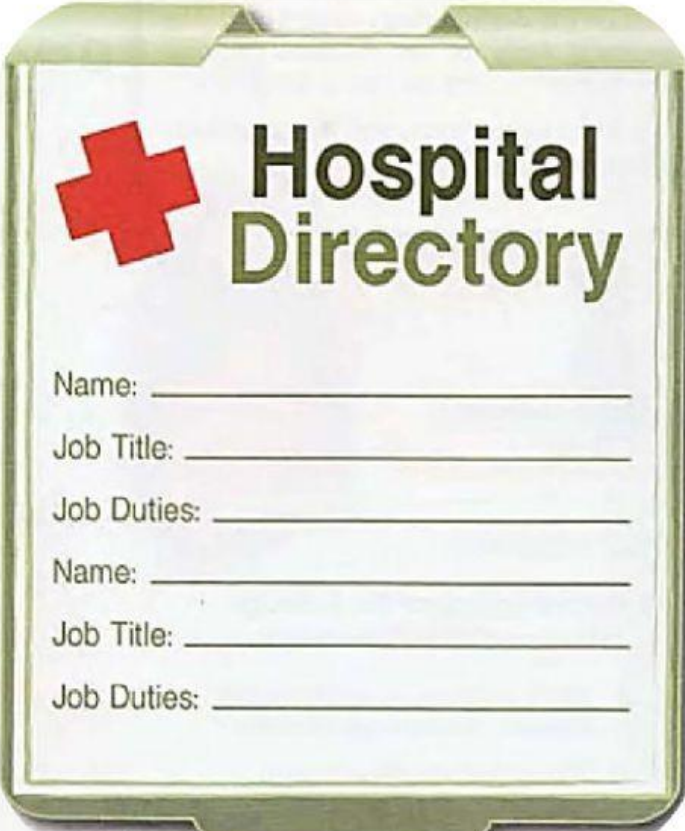
