


Objetivo:

PARA CONTRASTAR ACTIVIDADES QUE REALIZAMOS NORMALMENTE CON LO QUE ESTAMOS HACIENDO EN EL MOMENTO, USAMOS EL PRESENTE SIMPLE Y EL PRESENTE CONTINUO.

Example: He usually *listens* to pop music, (present simple)
but now he's *listening* to classical music. (present continuous)




