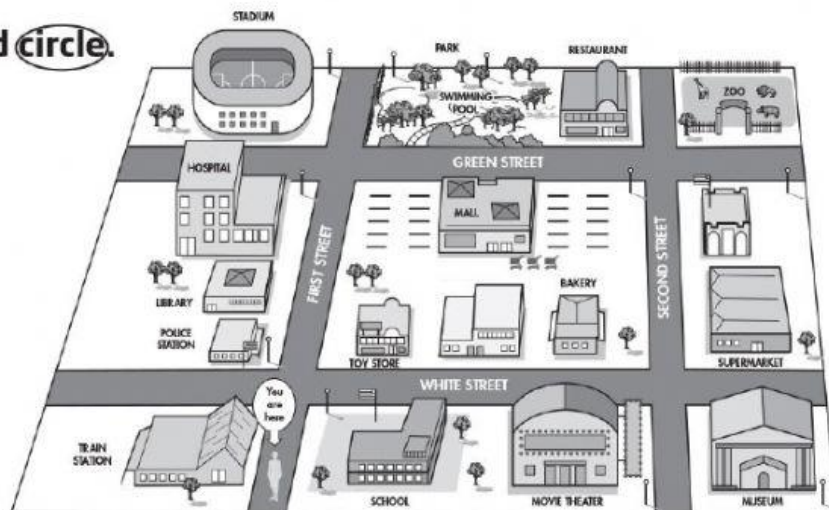


Giving directions

Question	Answer		
How can I get to the post office?	Go	straight. (↑)	
	Turn	right (↻)	on White Street.
		left (↶)	at the supermarket.

Use the base form of verbs like *go* and *turn* to give directions.

1 Look and circle.



1. How can I get to / Can you help me the police station?

Go straight on / Turn left on First Street.

The police station is **across from / on the corner of** the toy store.

2. How can I get to / Can you help me, please?

Yes, sure.

How can I get to / How can I help the swimming pool?

Turn **left / right** on Green Street. It's **between / across from** the park and the restaurant.

3. How's / How can I get to the stadium?

Turn left on / Go straight on First Street.

Turn left on Green Street. / Turn right on Second Street.

It's across from the **post office / hospital**.
